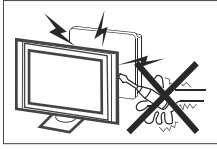
Article 820 of the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA No. 40 provides guidance for correct grounding. Specifically, it states that the cable ground must be connected to the grounding system of the building as close to the point of cable entry as practical.

- 7) For added protection for your device receiver during a lightning storm, or when it is left unattended and unused for long periods of time, unplug it from the power outlet and disconnect any antenna or cable system. This helps prevent property damage and personal injury from lightning and power line surges.
- 8) An outside antenna system should not be located in the vicinity of overhead power lines or other electric light or power circuits, or where it can fall into such power lines or circuits. # INSTALLATION

## Front panel



### KEYBOARD

1. When the TV is turned on, press the local key for more than 3S to enter standby.
2. For the third-party application, main scene and USB, only the operations in above are detected, and the following 3 operations are not executed.
3. Press the local key for less than 3S to enter the local key menu.  
The local key menu includes six options: on / off, program +, program -, volume +, volume -, and program source.
  - a) When the local key menu is displayed, the key time is less than 1.5s, and the focus moves backward once in sequence;
  - b) When the local key menu is displayed, the long key pressing time is greater than 1.5s, and the function of entering the current focus option is executed.

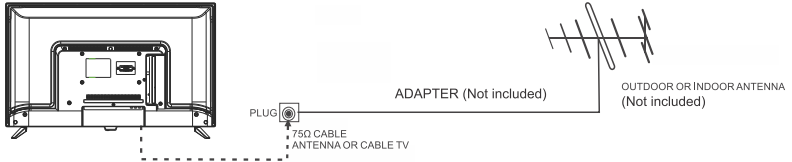

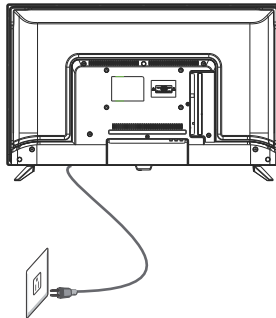
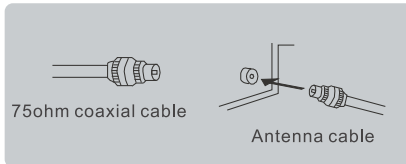

When shipped from the factory, the Signal Type option is for the RF connector (F-type) set to the "AIR" (Over-the air antenna) mode.

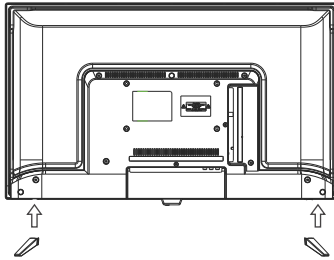

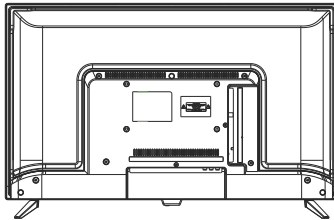
The base stand

Prepare to place the TV with the display side down on a flat surface. Due to the size and weight of this TV, the use of 2 people is recommended when moving it. Ensure the table or desk you use provides a flat, totally clean surface, and use a soft cloth between the face of the TV and the table to protect the TV's screen.

1. Locate the 2PCS of the base stand and insert it into the gap in the bottom of the TV , and check that it is securely held in place as below.



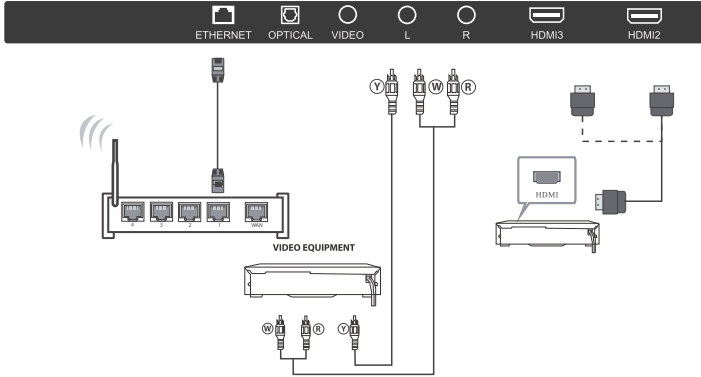
2. Lock 4 screws in the designated location as below and check each screw is firmly tightened.

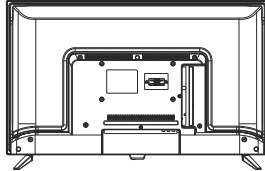

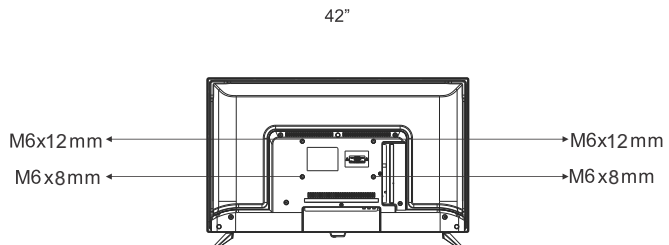
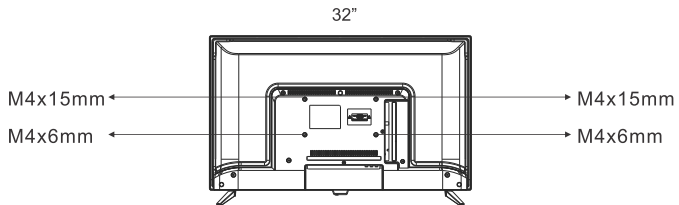
# Wall Mount

## Instruction for Wall Mount

1. Place the LED LCD Television onto a solid surface. Please place some soft material over the front of the screen to protect it from any damage.



2. Use the four screws provided to fix the TV onto a wall mounting bracket (not included) via the four VESA standard holes on the back of the television.

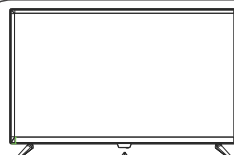

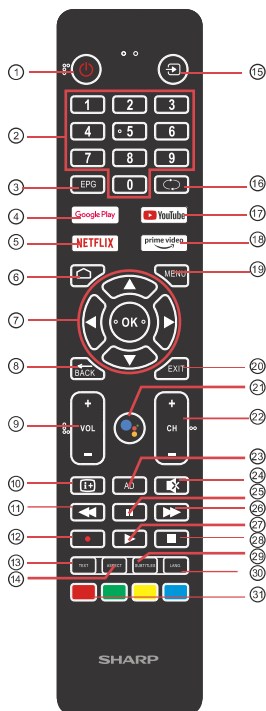

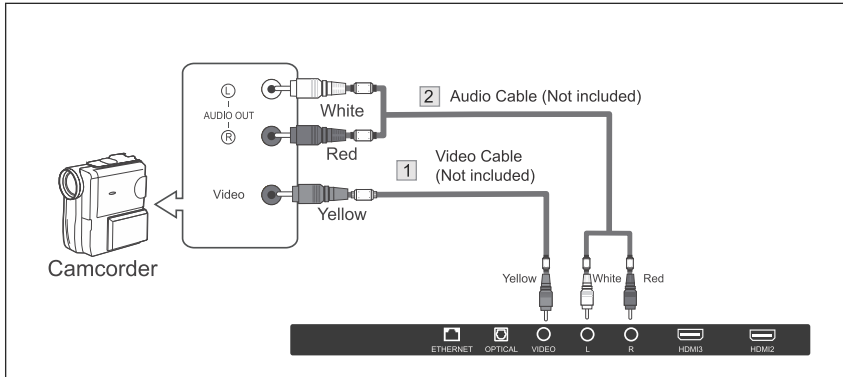

## External Connection

### Connecting a Camcorder

The rear panel jacks on your TV make it easy to connect a camcorder to your TV. They allow you to view the camcorder tapes without using a VCR.

Each Camcorder has a different back panel configuration. When connecting a Camcorder or DVD, match the color of the connection terminal to the cable.



1. Connect a Video Cable between the AV VIDEO IN jacks on the TV and the VIDEO OUT jack on the camcorder.
2. Connect Audio Cables between the AUDIO L and AUDIO R jacks on the TV and the AUDIO OUT jacks on the camcorder.
3. Connect a Video Cable between the AV VIDEO IN jacks on the TV and the VIDEO OUT jack on the DVD.
4. Connect Audio Cables between the AUDIO L and R jacks on the TV and the AUDIO OUT jack on the DVD.

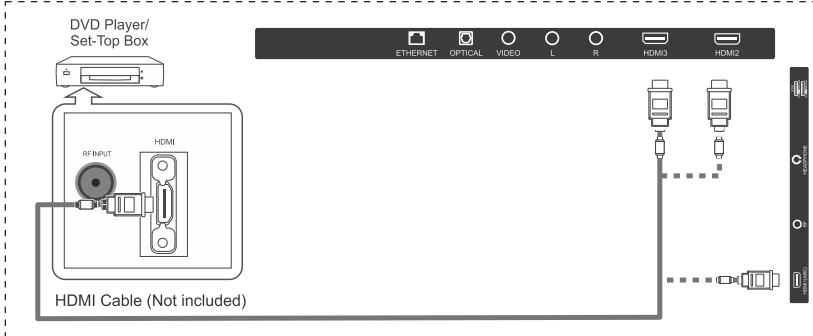

## External Connection

### Connecting DVD Player / Set-Top Box

This connection can only be made if there is a HDMI Output connector on the external device.



What is HDMI?

HDMI, or high-definition multimedia interface, is a next-generation interface that enables the transmission of digital audio and video signals using a single cable without compression. Multimedia interface is a more accurate name for it especially because it allows multiple channels of digital audio (5.1 channels).

The difference between HDMI and DVI is that the HDMI device is smaller in size, has the HDCP (High Bandwidth Digital Copy Protection) coding feature installed, and supports multi-channel digital audio.

Each DVD player/STB has a different back panel configuration.

Connect an HDMI Cable between the HDMI1, HDMI2, HDMI3, connector on the TV and the HDMI connector on the DVD player/Set-Top Box.

While using ARC, connect the ARC compatible external device to HDMI 1, under Live TV, press the "MENU" button to select "Speaker", "External Audio System"

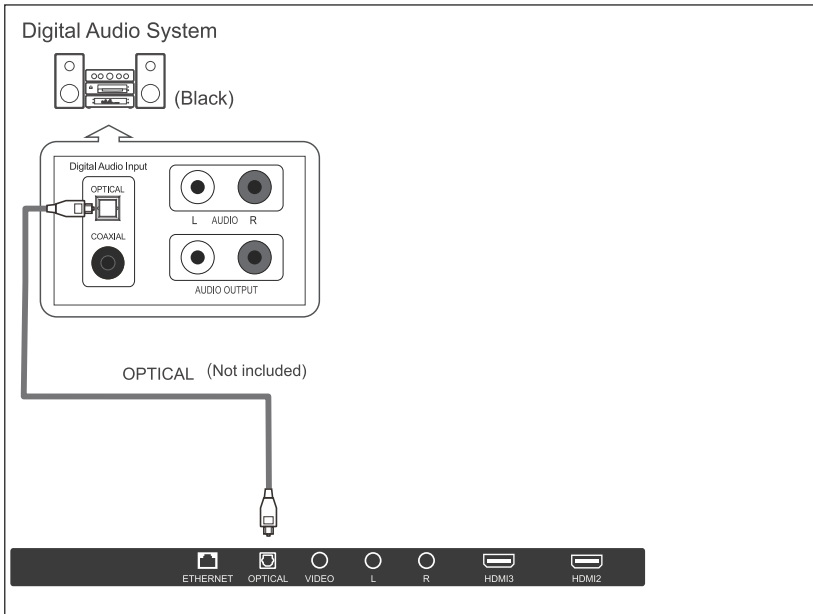

### Connecting Digital Audio System

The rear panel jacks on your TV make it easy to connect a Digital Audio System to your TV.



5.1 CH audio is possible when the TV is connected to an external device supporting 5.1 CH.

Connect an OPTICAL Cable between the OPTICAL jacks on the TV and the Digital Audio Input jacks on the Digital Audio System. When a Digital Audio System is connected to the OPTICAL terminal:

Decrease the gain (volume) of the TV, and adjust the volume level with the Digital Audio System's volume control.

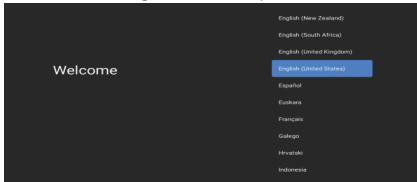

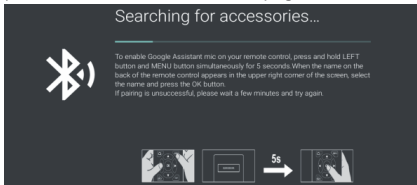

## INITIAL SETUP

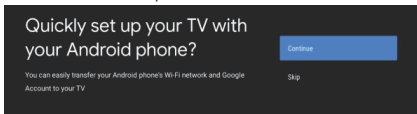
The first you turn your TV, the setup wizard will guide you through setting up basic settings. Please according to the Text Tip to First Time Setup.



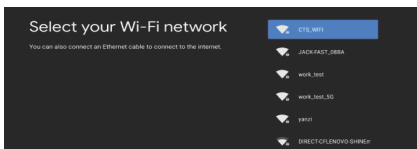
Press ▲/▼ to select the system language and press OK to confirm the language. If you are using an infrared remote control, please ignore the Text Tip and press the back button to exit this page.



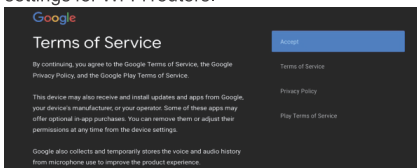
This function is used for the remote control pair code. To enable Google Assistant mic on your remote control, press and hold LEFT button and MENU button simultaneously for 5 seconds. When "BT\_VoiceRC\_20\_1" appears in the upper right corner of the screen, select the name and press the "OK" button. After the pairing is successful, you can use the Bluetooth remote control to operate the TV.



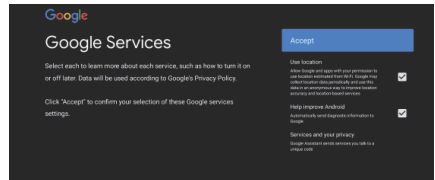
Connect your Android phone to your TV, select "Continue" to continue the connection, and choose "Skip" to skip this step.



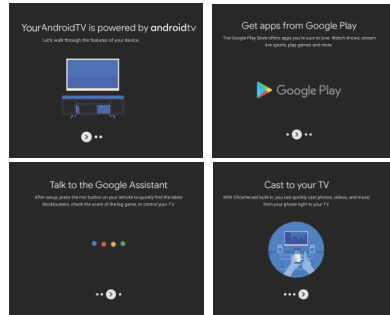
